

Medical and Medication Disclaimer

River City Family Health (RCFH) provides only general information about Montana Initiative 148. It is the patient's responsibility to familiarize themselves with the law, its provisions and limitations, and their own responsibilities. It is the patient's responsibility to submit their certification, with proper fees, to the Montana Department Health and Human Services at Montana Department Health and Human Services, Licensure Bureau, PO Box 202953, Helena, MT, 59620-2953. The patient understands that their card will be valid for one year; at that time they must recertify and obtain a new card.

RCFH recommends that patients **do not** consume cannabis until after they have received their Montana Medical Marijuana Registration Card from the Montana Department Health and Human Services. While this is a grey area in the law, RCFH recommends this course of action as the most prudent one.

RCFH is not able to discuss with patients all possible uses, benefits, risks, actions, precautions, side effects, or interactions of the medical use of cannabis (marijuana). Patients are advised to continue their healthcare with their health care provider to maintain their health.

The patient understands and agrees that their medical use of cannabis (marijuana) in any of its forms or preparations is undertaken at their own risk; further, RCFH recommends patients choose a medication route other than smoke inhalation, which may cause lung damage, cancer, allergic reaction or other problems. RCFH will not be held liable for any second-hand smoke illnesses related to smoking of medical cannabis (marijuana) that may affect others besides the client, including but not limited to friends, family, children, or acquaintances. The patient understands that no herbal product [included but not limited to cannabis (marijuana) or tobacco] of any kind should be smoked where children may be affected.

RCFH does not make any guarantee, express or implied, including but not limited to the efficacy, action, or the side effects of cannabis (marijuana). RCFH does not guarantee the availability, cost, or quality of the product from any particular caregiver. RCFH makes no guarantee that any service or product from any caregiver is or will be uninterrupted, timely, or satisfactory. The patient understands that obtaining the medical cannabis (marijuana) needed is between themselves and their contracted caregiver; the patient understands and agrees that RCFH is neither involved in the care giving process, nor affiliated with any particular caregiver.

RCFH does not make any guarantee, express or implied, that the patient will avoid legal ramifications related to the medical use of cannabis (marijuana).

The patient expressly understands and agrees that RCFH shall not be liable for any direct, indirect, special, incidental, consequential or exemplary damages, included but not limited to, damages for loss of health, profits, goodwill, use, legal difficulties, or any other untoward effect or action, resulting or arising out of 1) the use or the inability to use medical cannabis (marijuana), 2) the cost or difficulty of obtaining the medication, or 3) any other problems, difficulties, or untoward effects.

The patient understands and agrees that it is their duty and responsibility to read and comprehend the law, Montana Initiative 148, and to comply with that law.
